Speakers



Professor David Reutens is a clinical neurologist specializing in epilepsy and is a senior staff specialist at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital. He will talk about how carers and family members can prepare for a meeting with the neurologist. What information will be most useful for the neurologist?



Professor Nick Lennox, Director University of Queensland's Centre for Intellectual & Developmental Disability. He is a researcher, educator, advocate & medical clinician. He developed the Developmental Disability Therapeutic Guidelines Book, performed RCTs in people with intellectual disability & lead writing of part of the WHO World Report on Disability 2011. Nick will launch the website and explain the importance of this information and why this kit / website was developed with Epilepsy Queensland. He will also examine the healthcare needs of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and the importance of comprehensive health assessments with good history taking.

Yvette McMurtrie, Client Services Coordinator at Epilepsy Queensland will address practical guidelines for the care of epilepsy in the home, school and disability sector including how to recognize and manage the different seizure types, seizure observation and recording, emergency management plans and the use of midazolam.

Charlene Mundy, Epilepsy educator and RN, Epilepsy Queensland. The National Disability Insurance Scheme will bring about significant change for families and individuals living with intellectual and developmental disability. The scheme will allow families and individuals to exercise greater choice and control over their supports. So what does all that mean for you? Charlene will summarize the principles of the NDIS and highlight what individuals and families will need to consider as they start to prepare for the NDIS. This session will also incorporate a panel of families who are currently self directing funding.
